Our aim is to give the young people in our club the same opportunities as other young people - to belong to a club and learn to participate in a sport, to maximise their potential in their chosen sport and to take part in competitions both at home and away. Every year our gymnasts compete either in Jersey or in England.

The Gymnasts start their training at the age of three/four. We hold two sessions a week at the Western Community Centre and we are training approximately 60 gymnasts per week. The club is run entirely by volunteers, some of whom help at the gym sessions, others form part of the committee that runs the club.

We are a registered charity and as such receive no help from the States of Guernsey. We are entirely dependent on donations. All the money given to the club is used to help a Guernsey child with special needs.
